The whole family depend on the income which comes from a small van. He has three more siblings. The more surprising fact is that, the child had been suffering from teeth damaged from last few days. Due to that, he does not eat food from last few days properly.

- > We should take him to doctor immediately.
- ❖ How we can arrange doctor in this festive session?
- Let's try our best.

After exploring the availability of doctor, Fortunately Dr. Ajay Roy (A dentist at Bishnupur Hospital) was available at the moment and he immediate took him for the treatment.**Dr** A. Roy immediately treated the child by free of cost. Despite of that, Dr. Roy handed over some money and provide all the required medicines free of cost to the child.

So, when all the society engaged to celebrate Durga puja with their beloved families and busy to wearing new dress, some part of our society might face lots of pain, sadness so on, which need to be addressed. Sometimes we need **Extend ourselves beyond** the **Festive mode to help the needy people**/ community/ children...
